

Guidelines for Granting EMERITUS Status

The Executive Committee of the Houston Metro NACBA Chapter will use the following guidelines for granting the Emeritus status: Those applying for Emeritus status should have been an Active or Associate member for:

1. at least ten years,
2. attended the Chapter a minimum of six times each year,
3. attained age 55, and
4. entered into a retirement recognized by the local congregation or institution for whom the applicant last worked. It is further understood that retirement means that the applicant is not engaged in any full-time Christian business administration employment.

Applications must be received by the President by the middle of the month for Executive Committee consideration before final approval.
